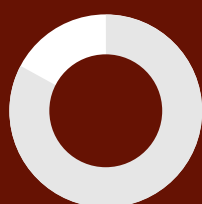

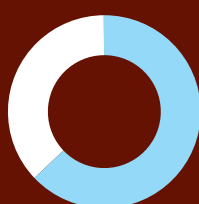

MBA direct entry requirements

You must meet one of the following Academic Qualifications criteria:

A BACHELOR'S DEGREE +3YRS

(AQF Level 7) or equivalent and at least three years of relevant work experience.

OR

AQF LEVEL 8 QUALIFICATION +3YRS

(AQF Level 8) or equivalent in any discipline and at least three years of relevant work experience.

OR

GCM +3YRS

A Graduate Certificate in Management and at least three years of relevant work experience.

Don't meet these yet?

Start with the Graduate Certificate in Management (GCM)

The AIB GCM is the first stage of the AIB MBA. If you don't meet the direct entry MBA requirements, you may be able to enrol in our GCM pathway through the following:

A MINIMUM OF FIVE YEARS OF RELEVANT WORK EXPERIENCE

Which includes at least three years of management experience or significant technical experience.

OR

A BACHELOR'S DEGREE +2YRS

(AQF Level 7) and at least two years of relevant work experience

OR

AN ADVANCED DIPLOMA OR ASSOCIATE DEGREE +3YRS

(AQF Level 6) or learning equivalent to an AQF Level 6 qualification and at least three years of relevant work experience.

OR

MINIMUM GMAT SCORE OF 550 +3YRS

Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT) with a minimum score of 550 and at least three years of relevant work experience.

Recognition of prior learning

If you currently hold a qualification in a business-related field, you could use AIB's Credit Transfer policy to recognize your prior achievement, helping you earn an MBA faster, for less.

English requirements

Our program is conducted entirely in English, and all candidates must meet AIB's English proficiency requirements, irrespective of their location. In areas or nations with more than one official language, documentation proving that your previous education was in English may be necessary.
